

## AcuPoint Analysis RHINITIS\*

(DESCRIPTIONS)

Point	Description
G16	1 cun below the area where the skull joins the spine (cervical atlas), on the spine.
G20	On the midpoint of the skull on a line connecting the tops of the ears.
GB20	This point is right under and against the base of the skull, in the two small muscular grooves at the back of the neck, two to three inches apart depending on the size of the head.
LI04	On the back of the hand between the thumb and index finger metacarpal bones. Find the spot midway on the bone that connects the index finger to the wrist. Sometimes this point is easy to find by squeezing two fingers together to form a small mound and marking an imaginary point at the peak of that mound. Then probe inward toward the main body of the hand, right on the bone.
LI19	The width of one thumb from the face centerline, midway between the nose and the upper lip.
LI20	At the flare of the outer nostrils where they join the cheek, on the cheek, rather than on the nostrils.
P08	Between the second and the third metacarpal bones of the hand, where the tip of the middle finger touches when the fist is clenched.
ST02	One-half thumb width below the center of the lower eye ridge in an indentation of the cheek.
UB10	0.5 cun just beneath the base of the skull, on the ropy muscles and 0.5 cun from the spine midline.
EST03	Master Point 5: Chinese Inner Nose (Nasal Cavity), French Master Ocillation Point, Reticular Formation, Auditory Nerve, Deafness, Dumb Point. Located on the 3rd zone of the Subtragus. This point balances the left and right Cerebral Hemispheres, correcting problems of cerebral laterality.
EHX01	Point 0, Solar Plexus, Umbilical Cord, External Genitals .F, Penis or Clitoris, Sexual Desire
EAT01	FOREHEAD, THYROID CONTROL (TSH), EYE DISORDER 2 (MU 2)
ESC06	KIDNEY .C, URETER .C
ECW08	ADRENAL GLAND, LUMBAR SYMPATHETIC GANGLIA
ETF02	Master Point 1, (Shen Men), French Hip, Chinese Shen Men (Divine Gate), Pelvic Cavity, French Wonder Point. Located in the middle of the 2st zone of the Triangular Fossa. This master point alleviates pain, tension, anxiety, and depression.
EIT02	Endocrine Point, Internal Secretion, Thyrotropins (TSH).
